Garden 3: Choir 2000/Cambridge Sinfonietta

Garden 10: The Impingtones

Friendly not-for-profit community choir in Histon and Impington since 2016. *2 to 2.30pm and 3 to 3.30pm.*

Garden 12: Classical piano/Cambridge Ten Sing

Ten Sing are an informal YMCA-based performing arts group for young people aged 11-18. *2pm Classical piano (either in garden or church); 3pm Ten Sing in Garden.*

Garden 13: Mythopoeic

Katherine Galvin and Jay Monk, young folk singer songwriter multi-instrumentalists. They play mainly their own songs with some music from the tradition and “folked up” interpretations of more contemporary material. *2 pm and 4 pm with breaks.*
